The paper, A New Record of *Henckelia Infundibuliformis* for India From Arunachal Pradesh, aims to report *Henckelia Infundibuliformis* as a new record for India. This finding is valuable for the flora of India.

The introduction is very short, and the authors should expand the introduction by adding information such as the center of diversification of the genus, the habitat of the genus, the history and distribution of *Henckelia Infundibuliformis* in neighboring areas, the diagnostic characters of the genus, and the aim of the paper.

In materials and methods, it is not clear which Flora was used for this determination. Which herbaria/collections were investigated for studying *Henckelia Infundibuliformis*? Which parts of India did you study during the field trip? Did you study the type species? Did you use virtual herbaria for this study?

I would suggest the authors provide a distribution map for the species, including specimens that they examined and specimens from neighbors. Examining one specimen is not enough; at least investigating a virtual herbarium is necessary.
