REVIEW COMMENTS

The research piece by the authors provides interesting research outcome that could contribute to knowledge within the context of COVID-19 interventions. The authors however need to take a critical look at the following comments and suggestions. The authors could either respond by addressing the issues raised or provide appropriate rebuttals where necessary.

- 1. A brief writeup on fibroquel hinging on its active ingredient, formulation, commercial availability, pharmacokinetic and pharmacological properties could be included in the abstract or body.
- 2. Appropriate references should be assigned to the first two proposed mechanisms.
- 3. In the last eight lines of the body, the references or citations should be decoupled from each other. The exact references should be assigned to the corresponding sentences.
- 4. The data sampling method and size, and the appropriate statistical tools for drawing the conclusions on the finding should be clearly stated.
- 5. No appropriate data is assigned to the actual efficacy of fibroquel in the COVID-19 treatment intervention. The authors could reconsider this.
- 6. Suggestion: The author could consider this suggestion if possible.

The research paper could also be presented as a research article that encompasses the following:

- i. Background/Introduction
- ii. Methodology (Parameters and appropriate data collection methods and statistical analysis).
- iii. Results and discussion
- iv. Conclusion and recommendations

This could give room for detailed background/introduction, methodology for data collection on the efficacy, adverse effects, mortality and other relevant biostatistical data fibroquel.
