

Review of: "How Competent are Health Professionals in Delivering Nutrition Education? A Cross-Sectional Study in Ebonyi State, Nigeria"

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Potential competing interests: No potential competing interests to declare.

1. Recommend changing the title. The survey does not assess how the HCPs *deliver* education, it only assesses their nutrition knowledge.
2. Dietitians are uniquely trained to give nutrition education. Including them (n=4) as general HCPs in this survey is misleading.
3. "Respondents who were physiotherapists were 17 times more likely to demonstrate competency in nutrition education compared to dietitians." How is this possible? This contradicts data in table 6.
4. Please explain how these two statistics are true for the same population: 7.4%, had good knowledge of nutrition while 43.0% (180), had adequate competency in nutrition education.
