The topic is relevant for epidemiological aspects. However, the title does not reflect what is described in the text, which illustrates how in different areas of healthcare facilities, diseases can be spread and how a number of solutions to limit the exposure of susceptible subjects. What is described is rather general and not entirely new, but it could provide a framework for broadening and deepening the topic. However, there is also a need to place more emphasis on transmission routes, such as air, which is a critical matrix for airborne diseases, as demonstrated during the recent Covid-19 pandemic. It might also be useful and recommendable to present some summary tables to help focus on aspects related to the various areas considered. The work can be published if the purpose of the work presented is clarified, a different title is identified, and a more precise focus on the importance of air quality in the transmission of infections is included. It would also be necessary to dissolve acronyms in the text when they appear for the first time.
