Your study's outcome will provide new insights into the current research. However, there are a few points to be addressed.

- 1. The topic can be 'Corporate giving as earnings quality signal: new evidence from Nigeria.'
- 2. The theoretical lens of the issue being addressed must be included in the introduction section.
- 3. The paper does not demonstrate an adequate understanding of the relevant literature in the field and therefore failed to cite/use current range of literature sources to reflect current thinking. I suggest the authors use the papers below, among others, to beef up the literature review section,

- 4. The methodology section seems okay. I suggest the authors test for endogeneity and heteroskedasticity in the dataset before running.
- 5. The figures under Table II can be reduced to about four decimal places apart from the observation
- 6. The general quality of communication needs improvements in clarity of expression and readability, such as sentence structure and grammatical errors. Proofreading may help.
