There are two questions to clarify the following points in here.

- 1. You mentioned that physical health indicators could predict CVD mortality among people. For this reason, did you clarify additional question in the survey? History of CVD, prevalence of higher risk (≥30%) for CVD, the mean arterial blood pressure, prevalence of arterial hypertension, number of heart rate, arterial fibrillation etc. If no, can you explain more the idea?.
- 2. After the response of "How did the Gulf oil spill affect your household income?", your team was identified as decreased: 19.41%, increased: 2.72%, and no change: 77.87%. Can you confirm that this increase or decrease is related to the oil spill?
