The paper "Young Builders vs. University of Delhi: A case of maintenance of balance between environment and development in housing development for the megacity of Delhi" is the attempt to use the case of Young Builders vs. University of Delhi to illustrate and discuss the dilemma of environmental limits and social issues, such as the urgent need for housing. The material presented in this publication is highly detailed and could serve as a basis for scientific paper. However, in its' current form this publication cannot be regarded as scientific research paper and could be considered as a report on the specific legal case. In order to transform this material into scientific paper it is necessary to re-structure the material, to shorten case description considerably, to set the case study and the debate environmental protection vs. housing development into appropriate research context by performing literature review and analysis on the topic. Moreover, the abstract and introduction should reflect the entire research not only list the circumstances and aspects of the legal case. The introductory section must clearly indicate the relevance, the aim and the methods of research. Currently the publication really misses contextualization, thus the reference list is really insufficient.
