A fluorescein conjugated to a preparation of lectin(s) extracted from the seeds of Wisteria floribunda (Japanese wisteria), with potential use as a diagnostic agent. Upon administration of fluorescein-conjugated Wisteria floribunda lectin, the lectin moiety preferentially targets and binds to carbohydrate structures containing Nacetylgalactosamine and galactose residues overexpressed on certain tumor cell surfaces. Using white and fluorescent light, tumor cells with increased lectin-binding affinity can be visualized or imaged.
