- 2. Consider conducting qualitative research to gather feedback from both providers and patients on the restructuring process.
- 3. Discussion: It would be beneficial to present similar restructuring models implemented in other countries, especially those in low- and middle-income settings. Comparing and contrasting approaches could provide a broader context for the study's findings.
- 4. Include a discussion on the cost implications of the restructuring. Understanding the financial aspects will contribute to a more thorough analysis of the feasibility and sustainability of the implemented changes.
- 5. The title mentions "challenges and opportunities," but these aspects are less elaborated upon in the text.
