I regret that there's no detail about the health and safety issues on construction sites related to climate change, whether it's the heat in summer, of course, but also the risks of storms and flooding. This is mentioned in particular in terms of the benefits of workshop prefabrication, but I think it deserves more than that—a development in section 3.3 of tomorrow's challenges, for example.
