Bringing and its introduction a little of the species studied, I think it is necessary to describe the recommended dose for the culture more clearly.

In the methodology I had the following doubts: Is there no reference to obtaining Pseudomonas putida inoculum? Where did the methodology used in the work come from? Wouldn't it be more efficient if the experimental design were in factorial?

An observation of the methodology is that the experimental design could be a little better described.

The methodology, results and discussion could be better correlated.
