GAIA Level 1 Assessment of Provider-Initiated Preterm Delivery is defined by three criteria: first, the patient is determined to be between 24 0/7 and 36 6/7 weeks gestation; second, documentation in the healthcare record as noted by the delivering provider of the absence of any signs or symptoms of spontaneous onset of preterm labor; third, additional documentation of the need to induce labor or to perform a cesarean delivery, resulting in a preterm delivery.
