A few small comments are

For the statement - an ideal hip radiograph requires passive external leg rotation, - I think the authors mean internal rotation

For the statement - Alternative analgesia should be considered in addition to skin traction, - skin traction is of no value in reduction pain (reference Cochrane review on this topic). Therefore the term addition is incorrect and should be that skin traction is of no use.

I feel the most relevant reference for nerve blocks is the updated Cochrane review on this topic.

Overall decision to publish will depend on the journal policy / acceptance for narrative review articles.
