

Review of: "Measuring the Effectiveness of Internship Programs in Aligning Education with Industry: A Comprehensive Analysis of Internship Outcomes in the College of Communication and Media During COVID-19"

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This topic is important. I believe the authors have more to say in looking at their research results. It would be very useful to know the structure of the internship papers that students completed. What exactly were they asked? We could hypothesize that their internship experiences did teach them about soft skills such as building confidence, communicating orally and in writing, and perhaps even selling, resolving conflicts, and understanding clients needs. They probably learned some but not others. The methodology needs to be explained a bit better for the lay reader, e.g. what exactly does coverage mean? Also in the paragraph after Figure 3, it would be useful to show the plotted curve and not just assert that it is not normal.
