More explanation is needed on how the survey questions accurately measured the UTAUT model concepts. Some of the survey questions don't seem to fully match what they are supposed to measure. More background details are needed about the nursing students beyond just their gender, age, and education level. Adding more tech-related details would help put the results in context. Since the study collected data at one point in time, it can only show relationships between factors but not changes over time. So we can't definitely say whether certain factors caused changes in technology use. The data was collected during COVID when classes shifted online, but the study did not compare emerging technology use before and after this shift. Making this comparison would better show the impacts of the sudden move to online learning.
