

Review of: "Grammatical Aspects of Feminatives Through the Ukrainian Prism"

This paper deals with a very important and up-to-date topic of using female and male forms in Ukrainian. It begins with an introduction with a brief overview of the literature. The next chapter is about the results and discussion. The paper ends with a very concise conclusion. The paper lacks a chapter where the methodology is explained. The author mentions using statistical methods but does not explain them. In the results section, the author says that he will analyze the feminative set given in (Плачинда 2018). This corpus should be described in more detail. It is stated that there are 13 problematic units out of 257 entries. However, it is not explained what that means and in what way the units are labeled as problematic. The analysis of the problematic words could be described in more detail, and the problems could be split into more precise categories. There should be glosses for the Ukrainian text – at least for the gender. The author should give more examples of using the logical OR.Overall, it is an interesting paper, but it still looks like a draft. Most of the claims could use further explanations. It could use additional research, methodology explanation, and some language editing.
