

Review of: "E-learning and the Use of AI: A Review of Current Practices and Future Directions"

The title of the paper is quite catching but it does not keep the promises implied. Instead of a review as it is usually structured, this paper refers to only one study.

In the methodological section, after quoting the data base consulted, the paper should describe the articles selected, the criteria used to select them, common or distinctive features. Nothing of this is in the paper.

Instead of comparing different literature, there is only one case study about the use of Chat GPT without even mentioning the author/s.

Furthermore, the description is quite synthetic and in a format not acceptable neither for a review paper nor for a research paper.

It is not clear how the References list is built. None of the authors reported has been quoted in the paper.

The impression is of a very shallow paper, written by author/s with little experiences in writing a scientific paper.
