The paper is interesting, but there are some issues that must be revised by the author:

1. The Introduction section must be expanded - missing information about the research object, subject, thesis, hypothesis, research tasks, methods, and methodology, etc.
2. The Introduction section is poorly written; it does not give the reader a proper reason for conducting the research, a clear objective of the study, and a strong background.
3. Literature Review section - missing.
4. Findings and Discussion section - missing.
5. Empirical results - I think that more statistical methods must be included, giving clear argumentation about the results. You can try to include inferential statistical methods such as hypothesis testing and analysis of statistical associations, including the Pearson Chi-Square, Independent-Samples Mann-Whitney U Test, and Independent-Samples Kruskal-Wallis Test.
6. Conclusion - must be revised. I suggest including limitations and suggestions for future research on the topic.
7. The references list is, in my opinion, not sufficient.
