- The inclusion criteria of selecting these 32 Government hospitals may please be added to the research methodology section. The readers would have a clear picture of why only these govt. hospitals were approached in the study and why not others (rationalize pls).
- The Discussion section if may please be enriched further with few of the Indian studies that reflects on the status of
 accessibility to medical support or other dimensions like education, employment etc. to the persons with disabilities in
 other parts of India, or also in global context is possible.
- The paper is nicely developed however at the end I felt as if some specific suggestions and recommendations to different stakeholders could have been made. This would make the research work significant to the concerned people and other departments associated with persons with disabilities.
