The manuscript is on the whole interesting and well written.

The abstract should be revised; it seems a mere introduction to the paper and does not summarize its contents.

The subtitle '*Behaviour*' should be related to the writing: an explanation as to why 'behaviour' has been selected should be provided.

The 'Swiss Cheese Model' is a theoretical model used in risk analysis. Why did you choose this model? What are its limits with regard to embedding Covid-safe behaviours? Are alternative models available?

Restricted behavioural programmes must be compatible with human goals. A wider and more detailed discussion on the differences that every country must face to find its own strategy should be added.
