While the Results section is detailed and supported by literature, the Discussion section lacks a clear connection to the literature, failing to engage in a theoretical discussion that links the study's findings to existing knowledge. It currently appears more like a section of conclusions; hence, improving this part is pertinent.

On this occasion, the article is accepted with modifications. These revisions should be sent for further analysis and enhancement of the proposed research article.
