Works that present success stories in the use of technologies to improve the teaching/learning process are always important. Although the topic is relevant, some care must be taken when writing the article. It is a fact that the author had a lot of work to do on the research, but she did not present a discussion of the literature in relation to related works, since this topic is not new. There is a need to present work that sought to apply augmented reality in schools and the results obtained. It is also necessary to explain who produced the instructional content used or where it was obtained from so that we can understand whether the quality of the material is a variable in the engagement process. Furthermore, two important points need to be considered. In the results, instead of presenting how the calculations were made, comparative graphs between the 2 groups could be presented, and the findings could be discussed. The results of the questionnaire should also be in graphical forms rather than the way they were presented. Another important point is that the references presented are very old for the topic. Many recent works are available for consultation.
