Great efforts; however, there are many points that need to be addressed:

In the abstract, do you mean entrepreneurial intentions or financial entrepreneurship? The content of the abstract is confusing and not comprehensive, and it does not include methodology, results, value, and originality. These points should be included in the abstract.

The introduction has a confusing structure and does not follow the scientific methodology in terms of the references used, gaps, and their logical sequence. Therefore, the ideas in it need to be supported with recent references from 2021 to 2024, and the gap to be addressed must be identified by linking it to recent references.

The literature review was not done as required and needs to be changed significantly, as there are not enough references to support the construction of hypotheses and assumed ideas.

With whom and how many were interviewed? Were the interviews structured or not, and why?

The discussion is very weak, and specifically, the theoretical and practical implications and future studies should be mentioned.
