1. The title of this paper does not accurately reflect its content and purpose.

The manuscript's title is "The Role of Women's Business Performance in Promoting Sustainable Development," and the research focuses on triggers of women's business performance.

2. The research aim of this paper is clearly stated in the Abstract and Introduction sections as "to analyze the determinants of women entrepreneurs' business performance in micro and small-scale enterprises", therefore, the literature review content should be adjusted accordingly and should concentrate mainly on the research review of "determinants". The literature review of "Women's business performance & sustainable development" section can be decreased or removed as necessary.

3. The figure of Conceptual Frame Work require optimization to enhance their aesthetic appeal.

4. The list of collection tools in Section 3.5 is redundant. Additionally, many of the definitions and explanations in Section 3 are unnecessary, such as the definition of research design "refers to the overall plan or strategy that a researcher adopts to answer research questions or test hypotheses in a systematic and organized manner". Common sense does not typically require such definitions in the manuscript.
