Title: Perhaps "tumour rupture" would be more appropriate a term than "tumour perforation".

Case presentation:

- 1. First paragraph first line: Consider "A 34-year-old woman reported dysmenorrhoea four months before this presentation."
- 2. Second paragraph: Consider "The patient had no other apparent cause for intra abdominal bleeding." at the end of paragraph after mentioning falling blood pressure and dullness on percussion.
- 3. Second paragraph last line: Consider revision "The lower abdomen was tender with dullness on percussion suspicious for ascites."
- 4. Fourth paragraph: Consider "An urgent laparotomy was planned, and whole blood/packed red blood cells, fresh frozen plasma, and platelets were transfused to stabilise the patient before surgery."
