

Review of: "The SARC-F is a useful screening tool for detecting primary sarcopenia but not disease-related sarcopenia in ageing polio survivors"

The study reported the SARC-F and the EWGSOP2 in ageing polio survivors. Positive for sarcopenia based on the SARC-F is related to the grip strength and gait speed but not muscle mass (i.e., BIA measurement). However, some points might be a consideration regarding the sample size, the recruitment of the participants and methodology of the study.
