

Review of: "Analyzing the nexus between Spatial Data Infrastructure Development and e-Government"

This article is a strong overview of the foundations of spatial data infrastructure (SDI) alongside the context of SDI in Zimbabwe. The definitions are clear and direct which make them easy to understand. The example of Zimbabwe is interesting, though I am curious about the integration of the Zimbabwe specific data into the Google Map interface, and what level of customization if any exists there.

I would recommend more details in section two, which outlines some pieces of SDI which are not necessarily fully explored or elaborated upon. The table is useful but noting how some of those pieces are interfacing with SDI generally and Zimbabwe more specifically could be helpful.

Overall this is a useful, direct piece in exploring how SDI works in Zimbabwe. More details and explorations would serve to broaden its appeal and utility in relevant contexts.
