However, the overall structure is somewhat loose. Too many citations also weaken the author's point. Therefore, the paper needs some further revisions.

1. The title is a little bit vague. Maybe it is better to change the title into

"Jung's thoughts on the meaning of life".

- 1. In the introduction, the theoretical and practical significance of this research needs to be further clarified.
- 2. The paper lacks necessary literature review. Important research achievements related should be sorted out to highlight the innovation points of this research.
- 3. There are so many quotes in the article that the author's point of view is obscured. Therefore, the author should appropriately reduce citations and highlight his own analysis.
- 4. The logic between the parts of the article needs to be improved.
- 5. The points in the conclusion are not clear enough. What is Jung's attitude towards the meaning of life? What are the practical implications of Jung's attitude? The authors should answer these questions clearly in their conclusions.
- 6. The language is clear. However, part of the repeated discussion, reduce the interest of the article. Therefore, the language of the article needs to be modified further.
