This manuscript is well-written and in alignment with the journal's scope. There are a few improvements I would like to suggest to improve the manuscript. It would be helpful if the authors considered these suggestions prior to final acceptance.

- The manuscript needs scientific and language editing thoroughly.
- The abstract needs more quantitative results. Provide your contribution and work novelty.
- The authors may elaborate the Experimental Setting and Research Design more clearly.
- More complex discussion would be needed. I would like to see more discussion here about the possible application of this method to other places of the world. What do the authors propose?
- Recommendations for future studies are not including in this study, so include the future studies.
- The conclusion section still lacks in short and strong conclusions. The main results, novelty and academic contributions should be emphasized in this section. Moreover, are the results obtained in this paper applicable?
