3. The study solely relies on secondary data. Incorporating primary data, interviews with industry experts, or more real-time data could add richness and accuracy to the findings.
4. External risks like market competition, regulatory changes, or technological disruptions could be considered.
5. The dynamic nature of the music streaming industry is touched upon but not explored in detail.
6. **Overemphasis on Financial Metrics:** While financial metrics are important, the paper could have expanded its scope by exploring other business performance indicators like customer acquisition costs, churn rates, or user engagement.
