Dear Authors, the revised manuscript is uploaded as Supplementary Data. You will find all questions, commentaries, and suggestions in there. Please correct adequately.

The manuscript is missing necessary QA/QC analyses, especially since concentrations were measured with a portable instrument. There are no detection limits, standards, duplicates, blanks, or anything indicated that makes the reader believe in the data. A sample grid is missing, detailed sample processing and materials used in taking samples in the field and handling in the laboratory, and a general map of the study area is missing (indicating geology, industries, agriculture, or any land use); in my version, there was a red arrow indicated instead of a map. There is no geological area description since soils can be as well formed by rock weathering; so what is the real background of elements associated with the insitu geology?

It is a beginning, but there is still a lot missing to make this paper a scientific contribution to society and the study area.
