1. I found that the title of this article is exactly the same as the PhD title of this author. I am not sure how to rate this article, but this is my opinion. If the Qeios publisher agrees, then I would suggest the title needs some adjustment. This may help readers distinguish between your paper and the thesis rather than having the same title.
2. In the abstract, there is no need to cite references. It should be more about describing what researchers have studied in this study, what has been found, and what researchers argue in the paper.
3. In the purpose of the study, the research mentions "What are the characteristics of a professor/Ph.D. student co-lead experiential group". In the discussion, the term has been changed to the course instructor/Ph.D. student co-facilitated experiential group. To me, any professor can become a course instructor, but not all course instructors are professors. Thus, revise the paper and use the suitable term.
4. Justify each paragraph so it would look much neater. The rest is well written. The author's writing qualities described here follow good academic and expository writing.
