- 1- The abstract of the article explains what the author reached during his conduct of that experiment, and it also briefly represents the content of the article.
- 2- The author had indicated in the introduction to the article the use of the importance of using plant parts in the treatment of many diseases, but he did not give consideration to the safety of these plants on humans as a quick effect or for long periods as a result of the cumulative effect of these compounds.
- 3- It is preferable for the author to indicate in the paragraph on collecting leaves and plant roots, the period during which these plants were collected and what is the stage of plant growth in which these parts were collected, and whether those parts were obtained in a ready-made form from other centers.
- 4- As for the method of conducting the experiment, there are no observations.
- 5 The author's findings can add original knowledge about the use of medicinal plants in the treatment of diseases.
