This chapter offers a valuable exploration of Elvio Fachinelli's work, highlighting the innovative legacy of this forward-thinking psychoanalyst. The text appears to be the product of thorough research on Fachinelli, whose critical stance positioned him ahead of his time on issues that have become central to contemporary psychoanalysis, particularly regarding the significance of race, gender, and class in therapeutic environments. The publication is certainly timely, coinciding with a revival of interest in Fachinelli's contributions to the field. However, while the content is undoubtedly important, the article suffers from attempting to condense what seems to be an extensive research project into a shorter format. This condensation results in a text that often becomes confusing, leaving many aspects of Fachinelli's work mentioned but insufficiently explained. A more effective approach would be to narrow the focus to Fachinelli's most distinctive theoretical contributions. Specifically, the author could concentrate on the epistemological shift Fachinelli accomplished by centering the body within his theory and his original conceptualization of language not merely as a symbolic structure but as corporeal as well. This perspective represents one of his most innovative departures from traditional psychoanalytic thinking. While the article does address Fachinelli's views on payment and the economic recognition of the analyst's work, these sections are particularly confusing. These economic considerations could be more effectively presented in just a few clear sentences that connect to his broader theoretical framework regarding embodiment. Fachinelli's critiques of traditional psychoanalytic settings for their potential to perpetuate subtle forms of violence and authority, particularly against marginalized groups, represent another area worthy of greater development. In summary, while this article makes a valuable contribution to the literature on an increasingly recognized figure in psychoanalytic history, a more focused approach would enhance its clarity and impact. By concentrating on Fachinelli's most distinctive theoretical innovations and their contemporary relevance, the author could produce a more accessible and illuminating text.
