There are revisions that need to consider as follows:

1. Some typing errors must be considered.
2. Typhimurium is the serogroup of *Salmonella enterica*. It doesn't have to be in italics and should begin with a capital letter. The name of this bacterium should be written as *Salmonella* Typhimurium.
3. The name of plants; in the first writing, the author had already indicated the scientific name in parentheses. Subsequent use can write the common name without the scientific name.
4. For all subsequent use of scientific names, the author can abbreviate the genus name e.g. *S. aureus*.
5. The abbreviated genus names should include the period e.g. *S. aureus*.
6. The topic 6 Antibiotic-Resistant Bacterial Strains; If the author summarizes the MIC and ZOI data as a table of each bacterium it will help readers to understand more.
7. All scientific names in REFERENCES should be italicized.
