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It is a very interesting piece of work, particularly due to the perspective of achieving an appropriate analysis of a method that is so widely available, even in the absence of experts. I have no objections regarding the findings and statistical data; however, the formulation of the method is complex for a reader who is not familiar with data architecture. Therefore, I would suggest either providing a simpler summary for the reader or including an image that illustrates the method to enhance comprehension and clearly highlight the importance of what has been presented.
