

Review of: "In-Vitro Antibacterial Activity of some Ganoderma Species: A Review"

The authors could enhance the manuscript by reorganizing it in the following ways: 1) grouping the antidiabetic activity under a separate section; 2) including anti-fungal, anti-viral, and anti-protozoal activities from the antimicrobial activity section, as the information about anti-bacterial activities is repeated in two sections and a table; 3) adding a section on the phytochemical composition of Ganoderma spp.; and 4) including the pharmaceutical formulation of Ganoderma spp. extracts, fractions, or compounds.

It is recommended to abbreviate the species as spp. and to abbreviate the first letter of the genera when it is mentioned for the second time, except when Ganoderma sp. is the first word of the sentence. It is not necessary to include in parentheses when abbreviating bacteria. Additionally, some words should have spaces between them and should have a final period at the end of the sentences. Finally, the conclusion should be improved and refocused on the manuscript after rewriting.

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
