Millimoles per liter; a unit of measure that shows the concentration of a substance in a specific amount of fluid. In most of the world, except for the United States, *blood glucose* test results are reported as mmol/L. In the United States, milligrams per deciliter (mg/dL) is used. To convert to mmol/L from mg/dL, divide mg/dL by 18. Example: 180 mg/dL \div 18 = 10 mmol/L.
