The methodology used in the study raises concerns. The paper lacks a clear and well-defined research design, making it challenging to evaluate the validity of the results. The absence of a robust experimental approach and clear data collection methods undermines the reliability of the findings.

Secondly, the fundamental aspects of the paper are problematic. The literature review seems incomplete, and there are significant gaps in the understanding of the subject matter. A strong Systematic Review should thoroughly analyze existing literature and present a comprehensive synthesis of the current state of knowledge in the field. Unfortunately, this aspect appears lacking in the manuscript.

Furthermore, the paper's analyses fail to meet the expected standards. The statistical methods employed are inadequate, and the data presentation lacks clarity, making it difficult for readers to understand the key findings. Additionally, the conclusions drawn from the analyses are not well-supported by the data presented.

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
