First of all, I would like to congratulate you for your article on Sustainable Agriculture and Climate Resilience. However, in order for your article to gain quality, it would be a good idea to pay attention to the feedback I have tried to write below and what other referees wrote.

- 1. The summary is unnecessarily long, it would be better to shorten it. Purpose, importance, method, striking findings and suggestions directly related to them will be sufficient.
- 2. There are too many transfers and word inconsistencies. For example, "Türkiye" is used in some parts of the text and "Turkey" is used in others.
- 3. It is written that economic modelling, policy analysis and literature evaluation were carried out. However, modelling, analysis and review/evaluation are not included consistently in the text.
- 4. Any researcher who just reads the title will suggest "more sustainable agriculture". You are expected to suggest how this could happen based on scientific data and method.
- 5. Many information transfers do not contain citations.
- 6. It would be a good idea to enrich your bibliography and make a comprehensive analysis and evaluation within the text.
- 7. There is additional information for an article throughout the text. It would be good to condense these and rewrite them in a more coherent and understandable way.
- 8. It would be good to discuss scientific studies from countries where there are exemplary studies on this subject.
- 9. You need to specify the data sources of the tables and figures.
- 10. It would be a good idea to organize your article under the headings of abstract, introduction, purpose-method, findings, result-evaluation, and bibliography.
