The study is of significant value given the rapid development of CSR in China and the wide influence of CNKI database (particularly among Chinese scholars). By conducting a bibliometric review, the authors give clear description and summary of how CSR studies evolve in China. The clustering analysis and trend analysis provide rich information. However, the study remains quite descriptive. In addition, it needs more explanation why the impact of supply chain should be ignored (5.2 Research Outlook). Third, it seems that some key articles are missing according from the citations and reference list.
