- 5- The paper lacks consistency in formatting and citation style for references. This inconsistency can detract from the overall professionalism and readability of the paper.
- 6- The paper contains grammatical and typographical errors, which can affect its clarity and readability. It would benefit from thorough proofreading to improve the overall writing quality.
