

Review of: "Larache's Coastal in Morocco: Evaluating Dredging's Impact on Fisheries and Shorelineevolution"

The article is presented in a very primary state of elaboration and, in my opinion, lacks a lot of basic standards of a scientific study. The structure is very confused. There are parts where it is difficult to know if they are related to results, introduction, or methods. The main problem with the article is the lack of basis to sustain any conclusion. The results are composed only by a simple and rough photogrammetric analysis from Google Earth of coastline changes and a simple graph of fishery landings in the area. With base on this poor data, the authors draw a lot of conclusions and list a lot of recommendations for the use of the area. I think that it would be necessary to use a lot of more secondary data (or primary data) and more detailed and quantitative analysis to sustain those conclusions. So, I regret to inform you that it is highly not recommended to use this paper as a reference for other studies in the same topic.

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
