Dear author, I am pleased to review your article, it is a well conceived concept, however few editorial and grammatic mistakes need correction.

The title has different spelling of Mattu Town from those in the text (Mettu), in order to make it consistent kindly use similar spellings. The title can be made more concise, please remove "In case" from the title and replace it with "In Mattu Town".

In order to explore determinants of vaccination status, it would have been more impactful if open ended questions are asked from the caregivers of those children who are unvaccinated/under-vaccinated. I am sure the author has collected and enlisted those also, and the distance to health facility has come out of those, but enlisting these would further enrich the determinants' list.

The rationale of the study can be beefed up by adding more strong justification points.

The discussion part may further be elaborated to include other factors that may be useful for the district officer to plan and reach out to these communities which are unable to vaccinate their children due to challenges faced by them.
