In general, the study lacks scientific rigor. Below are my revisions.

The introduction is rather messy. Please clarify the approaches to studying personality and their connection with epigenetics. Additionally, please specify the objectives and hypotheses at the end of the introduction.

Regarding the method, I do not see the results of the systematic review reported in a scientific manner. Why was a systematic review used instead of a meta-analysis?

What is the connection between the introduction, method, and conclusions? What are the practical implications of the study?

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
