In the keywords, it is suggested to include digital transformation.

The article lacks an Introduction, where the background, a description of the problematic situation, and the objectives pursued by the study are expressed.

On the other hand, there is a lack of a section describing the methodology used by the author for the systematic review carried out, where the following are expressed: the keywords, the search engines used, the period covered by the research, and the main articles. considered relevant to the investigation, among other details.

It is considered that the study should delve deeper into the concept of Sustainable Development and the SDGs.

Finally, the work carried out lacks a discussion section, where the authors can present their considerations about the systematic review.
