

# Review of: "Natural Surveillance and Natural Access Control: Implementation strategies for enhancing Safety in Indian Neighborhoods"

The review investigation titled "[Natural Surveillance and Natural Access Control: Implementation strategies for enhancing Safety in Indian Neighborhoods](#)" is based on literature data which is more in the form of report rather than a review paper. The study addresses the safety and security of Indian neighborhoods through the implementation of Crime Prevention through Environmental Design (CPTED) principles, specifically focusing on 'Natural Surveillance' and 'Natural Access Control.' However, the Abstract is more a repetition of Introduction rather than a summary of entire work. The method section did not outline the research design. How Literature survey is conducted? What are the keywords? How many research papers were referred and from which disciplines? The review keeps repeating arguments in all sections. It also identifies strategies to be implemented for natural surveillance, it does not describe how it can be implemented with respect to Indian neighbourhoods in present context and how it will be integrated with concept of privacy.

Manuscript can be benefitted with proper restructuring. References in text should match with bibliography and it should be in alphabetical order. For example Gupta et al., 2018 is mentioned in text but not in bibliography.
