Overall, I really like the paper. Good literature review. However, "Party" has more than two meanings. In addition to political affiliation, and social event, it has the legal meaning related being part of one side in an agreement or dispute, and the other meaning related to simply a group of people taking part in some activity such as going to a restaurant as a "party of four", for example.

My major concern is related to how the results are different (or similar?) to other books that are not written for non-native English speakers. Perhaps, the authors might considering addressing these issues in the general conclusion, that for my own taste, it is way to short and needs much more analyses.
