This review article should be considered for a short communication, not for a full paper because –

The manuscript primarily emphasizes theoretical aspects, with minimal attention given to practical applications or real-world relevance. This limits the usefulness of the work, especially for readers seeking actionable insights or implementation strategies. Furthermore, the discussion section lacks clarity and depth in explaining practical implications, which diminishes the overall impact and applicability of the research. The data presented is notably sparse and does not provide a robust foundation for comprehensive analysis or strong conclusions. Additionally, many of the references cited are outdated, and the inclusion of more recent literature would strengthen the credibility and relevance of the study. The absence of tabular and graphical representations is another drawback, as such visual aids could significantly enhance the clarity and accessibility of the information. Finally, the paper would benefit from a more systematic and coherent organization to improve readability and logical flow.
