

## Review of: "Factors contributing to labour unrest at the garment factories in Bangladesh: A cross-sectional study"

This paper discusses factors contributing to labor unrest at the garment factories in Bangladesh. Several research has been done on labor unrest, but I find this paper still interesting because it can provide an up-to-date picture of labor unrest in Bangladesh and the factors that influence it based on the latest data. Here are suggestions regarding this manuscript.

- 1. There has actually several research on labor unrest in the GRM sector in Bangladesh, therefore the authors need to explain the differences between this study and previous similar studies.
- 2. In Table 5 the authors present the regression coefficients and their 95% CI for 5 models. However, the values of the regression coefficients and their 95% CI for model 4 and 5 are exactly the same. I found that there are no differences in the independent variables included in model 4 and 5. Thus, model 5 should be removed.
- 3. It is better to write citations according to basic format (e.g. APA style), i.e., the author's last name and the year of publication.
